Why Mobilization?

Billions of people are living and dying without knowing about God's love for them and what He did to redeem the broken relationship with Him.

They've never read or heard the story of Jesus and don't realize how He truly changes everything—how eternal life can be theirs.

But many Christians—the people who are supposed to tell them—are too afraid, intimidated, or ill-equipped to take that first step to talk about Christ.

How will people hear the Good News if no one shares it with them?

How does it work?

We build relationships with **CHURCHES** all over the world to accomplish four things together:

- 1. TRAIN the congregation
- 2. **EQUIP** them with Scripture resources to support ongoing evangelism
- 3. Facilitate unique ways to GO—locally and internationally
- 4. Cultivate **COMMUNITIES** focused on evangelism

But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes upon you. And you will be my witnesses, telling people about me everywhere—in Jerusalem, throughout Judea, in Samaria, and to the ends of the earth.

Impact

The gospel changes everything.

Beyond the primary goal that people gain eternal salvation, there are incredible benefits that follow the gospel as it gets shared in communities.

Hope in Hard Places

The gospel brings hope and light to new believers living in difficulties and darkness—even if the circumstances themselves remain unchanged.

Church Growth

Multiplication happens as believers actively share the gospel in their communities and invite people into the fellowship and discipleship of their local church.

Societal Change

Wherever the gospel goes, and God's Word is read, lives change from the inside out, causing a ripple effect in the society at large.

Deepened Faith

Inevitably, obedience to the call to go and make disciples leads people to a greater reliance on God and a deeper understanding of the gospel.



At the Center

The movement begins at the intersection of everything we do: the local church.

The Church has been called to share the gospel, and it's into loving, local church communities that we want to joyfully welcome new believers for support and discipleship.

The sign of an effective movement is multiplication. To have congregations growing in their evangelism activity. To have churches bursting with new believers.

And all over the world, we're seeing it happen!

- · Believers are stepping out of their churches and into their communities for the first time
- · Young people are discovering simple ways to talk about Christ in their friendship circles at school
- Evangelism outreach programs are being energized by newly mobilized people ready to get involved

As a result, congregations are growing and culture is being transformed.

They worshiped together at the Temple each day, met in homes for the Lord's Supper, and shared their meals with great joy and generosity—all the while praising God and enjoying the goodwill of all the people. And each day the Lord added to their fellowship those who were being saved.





Igniting a Passion

Lighting a fire in people's hearts to share the gospel is the key to mobilization. And thanks to a simple model, more and more people struggling with fear or confidence are discovering it's easier to share the gospel than they thought.



TRAIN

Our Ignite events feature a dynamic, interactive training workshop called Grid where attendees learn simple, powerful skills to help them overcome their fears. It's a transformational experience that propels them into gospel conversations—many for the very first time!



EQUIP

As part of the training, each attendee also learns **how to use the Bible in their gospel conversations**. Whenever we can, we equip them with a Scripture resource to use right away.



GO

Then, attendees are given **an opportunity to "go"**, hopefully that same day. We've learned that going right away cements their newfound skills and confidence.



COMMUNITY

We'll join them as they go, **experiencing together** what it can be like to share the gospel. Then we'll rejoin the group to share how God used the experience in the lives of those we met, as well as in ourselves.

Instead, you must worship Christ as Lord of your life. And if someone asks about your hope as a believer, always be ready to explain it. But do this in a gentle and respectful way.

Fueling the Fire

ONGOING TRAINING

Training doesn't end with one workshop. Mobilized believers continue to have opportunities to learn more about sharing the gospel, fueling evangelism activity in churches, and leading teams.

ONGOING EQUIPPING

Resourcing evangelists with copies of **God's Word** has been a core focus of our ministry since 1911. Nothing can compare with the power of the Holy Spirit to illuminate the Bible to someone.

That's why we continue to share Scriptures with people when we introduce them to Jesus in conversation.

And it's why we've developed unique resources, like Scripture magazines, to help "break the ice" and bridge religious gaps, along with training on how to use them effectively.

This pairing of personal testimony plus the Word of God is modeled around the world as we mobilize the Church for evangelism.

You have been taught the holy Scriptures from childhood, and they have given you the wisdom to receive the salvation that comes by trusting in Christ Jesus. All Scripture is inspired by God and is useful to teach us what is true and to make us realize what is wrong in our lives. It corrects us when we are wrong and teaches us to do what is right.


During our GO Trip in May 2022, we visited a high school where a woman named Constanza was working. She wasn't a believer and didn't attend church, but she heard the gospel being presented that day. She also received a copy of the *Hope* and *Spark* magazines, which she took home.

Sometime later, Constanza, along with her husband and three daughters, arrived at one of the churches whose contact information had been stamped on the back of the magazines. They wanted to talk to someone who could tell them more about what they'd read in the magazines about God and His Son, Jesus.

The Spark magazine had really caught their attention. It had a unique way of internalizing the love of God in a playful, entertaining, and close way, and it allowed them to understand the love of God—including their daughters. And it encouraged them to visit the church together.

They found the truth of God's love in the gospel. Now the whole family is part of the church's discipleship and ministry programs. The spark of the gospel was ignited in their hearts!

EVANGELISM-FOCUSED LIVING

When people are on fire to share the gospel, they don't wait for special events to do evangelism. It's a part of their daily life.

Our longing is to see believers trained and equipped to go share the gospel and God's Word with everyone in their lives. Together, we will evangelize the world!

CULTIVATING COMMUNITY

Togetherness stokes the fire. All over the world, believers with a shared passion for evangelism are praying together, supporting each other, and looking for new ways to actively share the gospel together.

These communities are most often members of partner churches, but can also be secret house groups, ministry partners, or even a national membership of Christians dedicated to evangelism.

North America

Mobilizing believers to actively share the gospel in North America has stiff barriers to overcome. But the simple skills learned in Grid workshops have helped break down the walls of fear in people's hearts this year.

Members in **Canada** continued to shine the light of the gospel in the public arena, and were active in supporting Ignite events across the country. These events not only touched lives with the gospel but also lit a fire in many people's hearts to become more active in regular evangelism.

Several GO Trips occurred in Canada, including two groups coming up from the US to share the gospel in British Columbia

New Scripture resources continue to be developed. A special *Hope* magazine for Northern Canada was printed, and several digital eMagazines were released for members to use.

I'm so grateful I had the perfect resource on hand to help my new friend James.



In **Two Nations** in Latin America, we have government-approved opportunities to reach as many communities as we're able. The demand far outpaces our ability to keep up.

Brazil has enthusiastic church partners eager to reach the furthest corners of their country, even into the deepest Amazonian jungles. Through GO Trips and partnerships, God is touching lives all over the country.

And in **Chile** and **Peru**, enthusiastic pastors demonstrate an avid willingness to do whatever is needed to help multiply the Kingdom of God.

The Nicaragua project has been growing as God continues to open doors—in more ways than one. After a 10-hour drive to the Atlantic coast, our staff member Dionisio and three pastors arrived in Bilwi.

They were there to inform the government officials of their activities, specifically the launch of the *Spark* magazine in the Miskito language. They also presented the Miskito *Hope* magazine and shared the gospel with them.

What they didn't expect was how the Holy Spirit was moving hearts in that office! A man named Marcio requested prayer—he wanted to receive Jesus as His Saviour. He started crying. He couldn't believe that God could forgive him and provide new life and salvation. He shook while praying to receive Jesus.

What a great opening for what the Holy Spirit was igniting in the northeast of that country. Praise God, the government office gave full access to schools and to share the gospel with the whole city!

Africa

Our church partners in **Kenya**, **Uganda**, and **Malawi** are enthusiastic about sending Ignite event participants out into the community to publicly share the gospel. As a result, churches are growing and believers are multiplying gospel impact.

In addition, GO Trips with members from various countries encourage local churches. They're given an extra boost of energy to step out into their communities to have new gospel conversations.

In Kenya, the prison system is increasingly open to our partner churches to make a gospel impact. They provide relational evangelism training and Scriptures to thousands of men and women, including the often neglected guards, chaplains, and staff. It's resulting in profound changes within their lives and the entire Kenya prison system.

George used to be a drunkard and a drug addict. After finding Christ, thanks to believers from a local church sharing the gospel with him, he knew he wanted others to experience this new life, too. So he took the Grid evangelism training at his church, and then headed out with a team of believers.

Despite the extra sensitivity, caution, and discernment that's needed in all ministry work in this region, the gospel is being shared. And God's Kingdom is growing!

Through special ministry partnerships, we're mobilizing the Church and finding new ways to use our tools. Thanks to technology, we're even reaching behind closed doors with satellite programming that's linked to our Scripture resources.

More than anything else this year, the *Spark* magazine touched lives and fanned the flames of evangelism in the Middle East. Through Spark Groups, hundreds of kids and their families learned about 12 key truths in the Bible that start with God's love for them and end with a brand new life in Jesus.

Phoebe's faith, like so many other believers in South Asia, is like a vulnerable candle flame in a thunderstorm. As an employee in a factory and a new believer, she cherished opportunities to read her New Testament on her coffee breaks. One of her colleagues noticed and started asking her questions about Christianity. Then her boss noticed, too, and he warned her to stop doing it. But Phoebe didn't stop, and finally one day her boss marched over, grabbed the New Testament, and tore it into pieces.

The very next Sunday, someone from ShareWord Global visited Phoebe's church and offered the congregation something new to help them share the gospel: *Light* magazines in the local language. So she took one to work and read it during her break. When her curious colleague asked for a copy, she gave her one. And this time when her boss saw what she was doing, he ignored her. It was "just a magazine."


